Staffing


We are pleased to share that we are experiencing a stabilization of our staffing. We have a great working team that keeps working to improve our services at CF.

Rainbow Fridge

We have entered into a partnership with Rainbow Kitchen, which has provided us with a fridge to support food accessibility at CF. They fill this fridge 3 times a week with muffins, fruit, and yogurt. The fridge is currently located in the library, but it will be moved to the main hallway so that students, staff, parents, and community members can access it when they are hungry. Classes use baskets to take food to their classrooms so that adults can supervise food distribution and minimize food waste. This program also supports our CF food programs (breakfast, snack and lunch). Thank you, Rainbow Kitchen.
